Bad Weather Arrangements



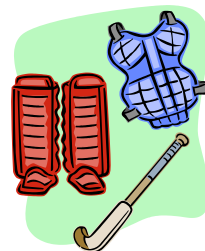
On some occasions – if it is snowy, very icy, thick fog or other extreme weather condition – it is likely that training will be cancelled.
