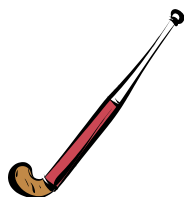


Mouth Guards

A reminder to parents/guardians

- For their own safety, parents and supporters are required to stand at the side of the pitch and are asked not to come on to the pitches during matches

Bad Weather Arrangements

On some occasions – if it is snowy, very icy, thick fog or other extreme weather conditions – it is likely that training will be cancelled.



Members of the Junior Committee are in contact with the Leisure Centre on these occasions if the pitch is unusable. It would be impossible to contact everyone but all Committee members will be informed - please contact them for confirmation if you are unsure.
